## **Oral Care – Dentures**

## **Huddle Talk #2**

## Did you know?

- Many problems can occur in residents who wear dentures if Oral Care is not done. Oral Care needs to be a priority!
- If dentures are not removed, allowing for the tissues to rest, infections such as thrush, or denture sore mouth can develop.

## **Recommended Daily Denture Care:**

- Brush dentures with a denture brush morning and night
- using a mild soap (suitable to use handwashing soap provided by the LTC home, Do Not Use Regular Toothpaste as is harsh on dentures)
- Rinse dentures well under running water.
- Brush gums and tongue with a soft toothbrush morning and night.
  Cleaning dentures is not sufficient: both the dentures and the person's mouth must be cleaned.
- Take dentures out of the mouth overnight, clean and soak in cold water.
- Disinfect dentures once a week. (Chlorhexidine solution or commercial denture cleansing tablet)
- Encourage the resident to drink water after meals, medications, other drinks and snacks to keep the mouth clean.
- Chart and report any unusual findings to the RN, RPN, or LPN on shift
