- The [Graduate Retention Program](#) provides a rebate up to \$20,000 of tuition fees paid by eligible graduates who live in Saskatchewan and file a Saskatchewan income tax return

Loan Forgiveness for Nurses:

- Choose to work in a community of 10,000 people or less and you can qualify to receive up to \$20,000 in [Saskatchewan Student loan forgiveness](#) over a maximum of 5 years (\$4,000 per year)
- Choose to work in a community of 50,000 people or less and you can qualify to receive up to \$20,000 in [Canada Student Loan forgiveness](#) over a maximum of 5 years (\$4,000 per year)
