

VALUES


- **SAFETY:** *Be aware.* Commit to physical, psychological, social, cultural and environmental safety. Every day. For everyone.

PHILOSOPHY OF CARE: Our commitment to a philosophy of Patient and Family Centred Care is at the heart of everything we do and provides the foundation of our values.














Saskatchewan Health Authority Occupational Groups by the Numbers








Licensed Practical Nurses in the SHA



CUPE & SEIU West 2022-23 base hourly wages:

- Graduate Licensed Practical Nurse : \$32.54
- Licensed Practical Nurse: \$36.16 \$38.72

Premiums:

- \$2.25 per hour for each hour worked on Saturday and Sunday
- \$2.75 per hour evening shift differential
- 1.5x the regular rate of pay for overtime hours worked

Saskatchewan Health Authority Rural & Northern Incentives

Loan Forgiveness for Nurses:

• Choose to work in a community of 10,000 people you can qualify for **Saskatchewan Student Ioan** forgiveness of up to \$4,000 per year, for up to 5 years, to a maximum of \$20,000. You must be working in a designated rural or remote community with a population of less than 10,000. The exceptions are Estevan, Weyburn and Lloydminster (Saskatchewan), which are also designated communities for this program.

Northern incentives:

• Choose to work in a qualifying northern community, and you will receive bi-weekly northern living allowances as part of the SEIU CBA

Saskatchewan Health Authority Changing Status

If hired with a grad licenses, the SHA will reimburse for both your graduate and full license fees. We do not cover any exam costs.

Upon passing your professional exam:

- Provide CPNRE candidate report to your manager/HR (follow local processes)
- Ensure your license is upgraded to practicing LPN within 7 days of passing your exam.
- Inform your manager immediately when you successfully pass and your ability to work to full scope.

If you are unsuccessful at the exam:

- Inform your Manager **IMMEDIATELY** of your plan to write again
- Ensure you get a new grad license before your existing one expires


