



Call your healthcare provider or go to your nearest Emergency Department if you have any of the following:

- shortness of breath
- swelling of hands and lower legs
- large and sudden decrease in urine output

### Procedural Information

- You received a contrast (dye) injection in the blood vessels.
- Before the injection, your kidneys were checked on how well they work and you could be at a higher risk for kidney injury.

### Follow-up blood work

- You need a **blood test** within **48 to 72 hours** to measure how your kidneys are working.
- Take all the papers we have given to you to the laboratory.
- The results of this test go to the doctor who ordered this exam and your family doctor.
