

# Child Health Clinics (January 1 - March 31, 2025)

# First Immunizations are due at 2 months of age.

Please book your appointment as soon as possible by contacting your local Public Health Office.

Public Health Nurses provide **free** routine immunizations funded by the Saskatchewan Ministry of Health. A parent or legal guardian must be present to provide informed consent for immunization. **Before arriving:** Read the vaccine fact sheets <u>https://www.saskatchewan.ca/residents/health/accessinghealth-care-services/immunization-services</u>

#### Standard appointment:

- For families who do not have a routine family physician.
- Routine immunization.
- Support for parents in promoting healthy childhood growth & development and answer questions.
- Offered at booked appointments only



#### Immunization Express appointment (20 minutes):

- For infants and children 6 years and younger seen regularly by a family physician.
- All age-appropriate vaccines are provided. Height, weight and screenings are not repeated.
